



## ACE Day at Six Flags Magic Mountain SATURDAY, SEPT. 8, 2018

### SCHEDULE

- 8:30 - 9:15 a.m.:
  - Event check-in at Main Gate Plaza - All attendees to pick up:
    - ACE name badge and ERT wristbands
    - Please remember to bring your printed park admission ticket (if you are not a Six Flags season pass holder or member) or your Six Flags season pass/membership card.
    - If you miss the morning check-in, a park representative will be available until 10 a.m. to give you your ERT wristbands and name badge. After 10 a.m., you will have to wait until the park opens at 10:30 a.m.
- 9 a.m.:
  - Gate opens
- 9:15 - 10:30 a.m.:
  - ERT on *X2*, *Full Throttle* and *New Revolution* (Please be advised that attendance must be at least 75 to include ERT on all three coasters)
- 10:30 - 10 p.m.:
  - Enjoy the park on your own
- Time TBD:
  - ACE exclusive Fright Fest preview
- Time TBD:
  - Q&A with park management on the new for 2019 attraction
  - Snacks
  - Drawing for prizes
- 10-Midnight:
  - Extended park hours - ACE has been given approval to join another private scheduled event for two additional park hours

### PARKING

- FREE PARKING BEFORE 9:30 AM (Show ACE membership card if you do not have a season pass or membership card with parking privileges). After 9:30 AM, regular parking rates apply if you don't have a Six Flags season pass or membership card with parking. Vehicles that leave the parking lot and return after will pay regular parking price unless you have a Six Flags season pass or membership card with parking.

### EVENT COST (Applies to both ACE members and Guests of ACE Members - no limit):

- Six Flags Season Passholder: \$0 (no charge)
  - Will need to present season pass or membership card at the park
- Non-Season Passholder: \$42.99 per person



## TICKET PURCHASE/EVENT REGISTRATION

- Deadline to purchase tickets and/or register for the event is **Sept. 3, 2018**.
- There will be a prize drawing for the first 100 people that register for the event.
- **Six Flags Season Passholders:**

    - Complete form.
    - For all names of additional ACE members and/or guests in your party, please indicate if ACE member or not per person. Also indicate whether this individual has a Six Flags season pass. **Important - If anyone in your party does not have a Six Flags season pass, a ticket needs to be purchased per instructions below in the Non-Season Passholders section.**
  - **All attendees must be registered to attend event.**
- **Non-Season Passholders - two-step process (purchase tickets; register names):**
  - Ticket purchase is through the Six Flags Magic Mountain website using a promo code.
  - All event tickets should be purchased by an active ACE member in good standing. ACE members should purchase event tickets for all guests in your party.

  - On the upper right corner of the Six Flags Magic Mountain home page, click on **Enter Promo Code**, type in the code **ACE**, select GO and follow the instructions to purchase tickets for all attendees in your party.
    - Purchase the quantity of tickets needed.
    - Payment methods are PayPal, debit card or major credit card.
    - Please remember to bring purchased tickets with you to event.
  - Please treat the promo code confidentially. Do not post on social media. ACE membership will be validated.
  - **Important** - after you have purchased tickets for your party, please also register everyone in your party [here](#). This is necessary in order to produce event name tags for everyone tickets have been purchased for.
  - Complete form.
  - For all names of additional ACE members and/or guests in your party, please indicate if ACE member or not per person. Also indicate whether this individual has a Six Flags season pass. This information will be used to cross reference the tickets purchased off the Six Flags Magic Mountain website.

## RIDE POLICIES

- Riders will be restricted by heights of over 48" and up to 54" for some rides. Due to safety concerns, guests will be required to abide by the decision of the individual Six Flags Magic Mountain ride operator. Guests of ACE are required to abide by the same rules of conduct, safety, and dress as any other guest.
- Inclement weather, equipment problems, or other unforeseen circumstances may affect the schedule including ERT Sessions.

## ACE'S CODE OF CONDUCT

- Attendees are expected to abide by ACE's Code Of Conduct to ensure that ACE is always represented in a positive manner. Members are to set a positive example for other park patrons, follow all park policies and rules, and conduct themselves in a polite, courteous and safe manner. This includes following regulations pertaining to line-jumping, use of seat belts, lap bars, shoulder harnesses and other safety restraints, and taking cameras on rides. ACE members who bring non-ACE guests will be responsible for the actions and conduct of their guests.
- Members found to be in violation of this code are subject to ACE's disciplinary procedures and may receive a warning, have their membership suspended or have their membership terminated.
